- 2. Age limit: 35 years as on the date of walk-in -interview (SC/ST/OBC/Persons With Disability (PWD) are eligible for age relaxation as per rules).
- 3. Tenure of the JRF will be initially for a period of One year and will be extendable on need and performance basis.
- 4. In case more number of candidates turn up for walk-in-interview there will be a subject oriented written test for duration of one hour and shortlisted candidates only will be interviewed on the same day itself.
- 5. Candidates should appear for written test/walk-in-interview in person with original certificates proving educational qualification, age, caste, experience etc., along with any other relevant information (like copies of publication, awards, recommendations etc.)
- 6. Candidates should enclose self-attested true copies of the relevant certificate/ testimonials along with the application and submit the same on the date of walk-in-interview.
- 7. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PWD should produce copies of the relevant certificates issued by the Competent Authority to that effect.
- 8. A 'No Objection Certificate' from the employer concerned is required in respect of those applicants who are employed under Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies.
- 9. No traveling or any other allowances is admissible for attending the written test/walk-in-interview.
- 10. The Institute reserves the right not to fill up the position, if it so decides.

- 11. The Institute reserves the right to terminate the assignment at any time before completion of the appointment, if it so decides.
- 12. No interim correspondence will be entertained.
- 13. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- 14. Government strives to have a workforce which reflects gender balance and women candidates are encouraged to apply.
