Qualification

- 1) Veterinary and Animal Sciences and Basic Sciences Faculties (except Agronomy), Directorate of Animal Production Studies and Directorate of Extension Education:
- (i) Good academic record as defined by the University with at least 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a concerned subject or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University. A minimum OGPA of 2.25/4.00 or 6.50/10.00 or its equivalent is essential.

The candidates should have the basic degree of B.V.Sc., / B.V.Sc., & A.H., from an institution listed in the Schedule 1 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 amended from time to time. However in the subject of Bio-Statistics candidates without B.V.Sc., / B.V.Sc., & A.H., will be considered only if suitable candidates with basic degree of B.V.Sc./ B.V.Sc. & AH are not available.

- (ii) The candidates should possess a Master's degree in the concerned subject with NET qualification.
- (iii) Ph.D degree with course work component is desirable.
- (iv) For the candidates having Master's degree, National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant subject conducted in the relevant subject by the ASRB, UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC shall remain compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived off for candidates holding the Ph.D., Degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009 (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D., degree), and the candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the cutoff date for qualification. Those candidates with Ph.D., degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- (v) NET shall not be required for posts with such Master's Programme in disciplines for which NET is not conducted. However, one publication in NAAS rated referred journal is compulsory.

Food Sciences Faculty Basic Subjects - Biochemistry / Economics / Food Nutrition / Food Microbiology / Biotechnology (Posts):

- (i) Good academic record as defined by the University with at least 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the concerned subject from a University recognized by UGC, India or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University. A minimum OGPA of 2.25/4.00 or 6.50/10.00 or its equivalent is essential.
- (ii) The candidates should possess a Master's degree in the concerned subject with NET qualification.
- (iii) Ph.D degree with course work component is desirable.
- (iv) For the candidates having Master's degree, National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant subject conducted by the ASRB, UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (SLET/SET) shall remain compulsory. One publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted is desirable. Essentiality of NET can be waived off for candidates holding the Ph.D., Degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009 (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D., degree), It is desirable for candidate to have at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the cutoff date for qualification. Those candidates with Ph.D., degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- (v) NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for posts with such Master's Programme in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

3) For Agronomy Post

- (i) Good academic record as defined by the University with at least 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant / concerned subject or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University. A minimum OGPA of 2.25/4.00 or 6.50/10.00 or its equivalent is essential.
 - The candidates should possess the basic degree of (B.Sc., Ag.) four years duration obtained from a recognized State Agricultural University.
- (ii) The candidates should possess a Master's degree in the concerned subject with NET qualification
- (iii) Ph.D degree with course work component is desirable.

- (iv) For the candidates having Master's degree, National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant subject conducted by the ASRB, UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC shall remain compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding the Ph.D., Degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has atleast two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the cut off date for qualification. Those candidates with Ph.D., degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- (v) NET shall not be required for posts with such Master's Programme in disciplines for which NET is not conducted. However, one publication in NAAS rated referred journal is compulsory.
