National Institute of Science Education and Research (NISER) Bhubaneswar, has been setup at Jatni in Khurda District of Odisha by the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India as a unique institution of its kind pursuing undergraduate and post-graduate education in sciences combined with frontline research. The campus of NISER at Jatni is spread over a sprawling 300 acres of land on the outskirts of Bhubaneswar. It will be a fully residential campus with all modern living amenities including children's school, health centre, banking facilities etc.

Details of Essential Qualification, Age and Experience:

Post Code-01: Scientific Assistant-C (Physical Education Trainer)

Essential Qualifications : Bachelor's degree in Physical Education (B.P.Ed) or equivalent qualification with 60% mark or equivalent.

Experience: 4 years training experience in Higher Secondary Schools/ Colleges/ Universities/ Educational Institutions of national repute as Physical Education Trainer (**PET**) or in similar capacities.

Age : Not more than 32 years as on 16th January 2017 i.e born on or after 17.01.1985.

Job Profile:

Physical Education Trainer will be responsible for organizing games and challenges that promote physical activity among the students and other campus residents.

- Give alternative exercises during workouts or classes for different levels of fitness and skill.
- Give emergency first aid if needed
- Their goal is to develop skills and physical development among young students and proper exercise and eating habits among them. Instruct students on importance of regular amounts of appropriate physical activity throughout life.

- Explain and enforce safety rules governing sports, recreational activities, and the use of sports and exercise equipment.
- PE trainer must adjust their curricula to adapt to those with disabilities or different physical abilities.
- Additionally, PET will have to coach sports team.
- They also need to demonstrate how to carry out various exercises and routines and be able to communicate and demonstrate the sports/games properly.
- In addition to students, may have to interact with parents, other teachers and the Institute administrators.
- Document attendance, grades and other records as necessary.
- Organize and lead group exercise sessions, which can include aerobic exercise, stretching, muscle conditioning or meditation, teach popular conditioning methods such as Pilates or yoga.
- Provide information or resources about nutrition, weight control, and lifestyle issues.
- PE trainer is often required to do a variety of tasks in addition to his fitness duties, such as creating posters and flyers, organising games and sports activities for the Institutes as per its requirement from time to time. He will often has to handle administrative duties required for the job profile or assigned by the Institute from time to time.

Common skills desired in a Physical Education Teacher

- Excellent verbal communication skills
- Strong motivational skills
- Possess patience and extensive knowledge of physical fitness, sports, and exercise

Benefits for NISER Staff:

- In addition to the basic salary, NISER staff member are entitled to the allowances as admissible to Central Government Employees.
- The Performance Related Incentive Scheme (PRIS) of DAE may be applicable to NISER (subject to orders from DAE), under which, there is a provision for monthly incentive of 20% of the basic pay.
- Scientific Officers are also eligible for DAE's update allowance, depending upon their scale and pay.

Only shortlisted candidates will be called for Written Examination/Skill Test/Personal Interview depending upon the number of applicants.

- 3. The Institute reserves the right to consider to fill or not to fill the position and or any other specialization(s). The Institute has the right to set different as well as higher norms, while short-listing, taking into account the specific requirement.
- 4. The Institute reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
- 5. Relaxation in age, educational qualification and/or experience will be considered in case of exceptionally meritorious candidates.
- 6. Examination/Interview etc will be conducted at NISER campus, Jatni, Khurda, Odisha.

- Before applying, candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria for the post as on the date of eligibility. The on-line applications are purely provisional, subject to verification of details/original documents when the candidate reports for the skill test/written test/interview.
- iii) The candidates have to pay application fee of ₹500/- (Rupees five hundred only) in the shape of Bank Demand Draft only, drawn in favour of 'FINANCE OFFICER, NISER' and payable at Bhubaneswar. Application fee is exempted for the women/SC/ST/PWD candidates.
- iv) Before applying the candidate should ensure that he/she is fulfilling all the requisite qualification and experience.
- v) The candidate should have a valid email id for applying, which should remain active till the end of the recruitment process.
- vi) The candidate should keep the following items ready before going for apply.
