2.5. Cricket (Men & Women):

2.5.1 In Cricket (Men & Women) at National level, representation of Main Indian Seniors Team in a Test Match or in a Limited Overs One Day International Match or in a Twenty-20 Overs Matches shall also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹ 1900 or ₹ 2000 in PB ₹ 5200- 20200.

2.5.2 In Cricket at National level, following sports achievements in 4 days/One day Limited Overs/Twenty-20 Overs Men/Women Cricket Championships (except Vizzy Trophy); organized under the aegis of BCCI may also be considered for recruitment against the post having Grade Pay ₹ 1800 & 1900/2000 in PB ₹ 5200- 20200.

2.6. Hockey (Men & Women): In Hockey for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹ 1900 or ₹ 2000 in Pay Band ₹5200-20200 at least 2nd position in the International Tournaments of four or more Nations, may also be considered. Participation in these tournaments may be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹ 1800 in Pay Band ₹ 5200-20200.

Note: (a) All the recruitments against Open Advertisement quota shall be at the minimum of the scale of pay.

2.3. Athletics: In Athletics sportspersons may also be considered on the basis medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Athletics Championship for recruitment in Grade Pay '1900 in Pay band' ₹ 5200-20200.

2.4. Badminton & Table Tennis: In Badminton & Table Tennis, sportspersons may also be considered for recruitment on the basis of their current annual All India Rankings in Grade Pay ₹2000 or ₹1900 or 1800, as per following criteria:-

3. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS : The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. Therefore, the sports achievements on or after 01.04.2013 will only be considered.

4. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

4.1. For GP 1900: The candidate should have minimum qualification of Intermediate or equivalent examination passed with 50 % aggregate. The condition of 50% marks is not to be insisted upon in case of SC/ST Candidate.

4.2. For GP 1800: Pass in Metric (10th) or ITI or its Equivalent or Higher education.

Note: Educational certificates/ qualification obtained from the institutions borne on the list of COBSE (Council of Board of School Education in India), an Association of National & State School Boards, will only be acceptable.

5. AGE: 18 - 25 years as on 01.01.2016. No age relaxation is permissible.

6. RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The recruitment will be based on trials, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates who are found fit in trials will only be considered for next stage of recruitment process. The recruitment process will be finalized by the HQ office and respective divisions/workshops. An application/candidature of a candidate can be rejected at any stage, if found false and Railway will not communicate the reasons whatsoever.

7. CONDITIONS FOR RECRUITMENT:

- a) Before applying candidate should ensure that he/she fulfil the minimum eligibility norms as given in Para 3, 4, 5 & 6 above.
- b) The name of the candidate and father's name appearing in school/college certificates and in sports certificates should be one and the same. There should be no difference.
- c) The specific position (Full Back / Half/Forward/ Required Kgs/ Wicket keeper/All rounder etc.) played in the particular game/event if applicable should be mentioned in the application without fail.
- d) In team sports, only sportspersons who have actually played the sport in field shall only be eligible. Therefore, a sportsperson who represents as member of a team in any recognized sports event/championship but has actually not played in the field, shall not be considered for recruitment against sports quota.
- e) For posts where there is initial training prescribed, candidates has to qualify the training before posting.

f) A caste certificate on the prescribed format for recruitment in Central Government services issued by the competent authority in the case of SC/ST should be uploaded for the purpose of taking relaxation as admissible.

g) The Selected Candidates can be posted anywhere & on any posts as per administrative requirements.

h) The candidates should be in readiness to appear for the trials at short notice after the last date for receipt of applications is over.

i) The Sports persons if posted as Clerk cum Typist have to acquire typing skill within a period of prescribed period at the speed of 30 words per minute in English or 25 words per minute in Hindi on Typewriter and if typewriting skills are tested on Personal Computers (PCs), then 40 words per minute in English or 35 words per minute in Hindi. If they fail to pass Type Writing test within prescribed period from the date of appointment, then his/her appointment will be treated as provisional till such time that he/she passes the Type Writing test and no promotion/increment will be granted.

j) The sports persons recruited against sports quota should pass the medical fitness test for the post, he/she is being appointed.

k) Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.

8. Serving candidates: Serving Railway staff and those working in Quasi-Administrative offices of the Railway organization such as Railway Cantens, Co-operative Societies and Institutes should have to upload No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by their employer.

9. EXAMINATION FEE :

9.1. No examination fee for candidates belonging to SC/ST/Ex-Servicemen/ Women/Minorities and Economically Backward Classes having annual family income less than ₹ 50,000/- .

9.2. Economically Backward Classes candidates means those whose annual family income is less than ₹ 50,000/- . They have to upload income certificate on prescribed format as per Annexure-D.

9.3. For Unreserved/OBC Male candidates not coming within the purview of minority/economical backward classes/PWD/Ex-Servicemen, examination fee is ₹ 100/- for all categories.

9.4. The examination fee is non-refundable. It should be paid ONLINE using internet banking or debit/credit cards (service charges apply for all which will be borne by the candidates). Applications not accompanied with examination fee, wherever required, will be summarily rejected.

10. HOW TO APPLY:

10.1. Candidates can apply through ONLINE mode by visiting the website of www.rrcald.org or www.ncr.indianrailways.gov.in Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the instructions available on the website. The onus is on the candidate to prove that all the information provided/ submitted by him/her in the application is true.

10.2. Candidates are required to go to the link provided for filling ONLINE application and fill up the personal details/ BIO-DATA, fee paid etc. carefully.

NOTE-I: Candidates should ensure that their Name, Father's Name, Date of Birth should exactly match as recorded in Matriculation or equivalent certificate. Any deviation found during Document Verification will lead to cancellation of candidature and also to debarment. In case any candidate has formally changed the name, then gazette notification or any other legal document, as applicable should be submitted at the time of Document Verification. Such candidates should indicate their changed name. However other details should match with the matriculation certificate.

NOTE-II : Candidates are advised to indicate their active mobile number and valid e-mail ID in the ONLINE application and keep them active during the entire recruitment process as important messages will be sent by email and on mobile which will be deemed to have been read by the candidates.

10.3. The examination fee of ₹ 100 for each category (unless exempted) should be paid ONLINE using internet banking or debit/ credit cards (service charges apply for all which will be borne by the candidates). After making payment of fee relevant details are required to be filled in the prescribed column of the ONLINE application.

10.4. Candidates are required to upload their scanned colour photograph of size 3.5cm x 3.5cm (Black & White photograph is prohibited) in JPEG format and 20 Kb to 30 Kb at appropriate place of website.

10.5. Candidates are required to upload their scanned Signature (in English or in Hindi) in JPEG format and 10 Kb to 15 Kb at appropriate place of website.

NOTE:- Photographs: The colour photograph of size 3.5 cm X 3.5 cm in JPEG format and 20 Kb to 30 Kb (not earlier than three months from the date of notification), with clear front view of the candidate without sunglasses, should be uploaded. Candidates may note that their candidature may be cancelled at any stage in case of uploading old/unclear photograph or Signature in Capital Letter or variations between photograph uploaded and the actual physical appearance of the candidate. Candidates are advised to keep two additional copies of the same photograph ready with them for bringing along with e-Admit Card and valid Photo ID at the time of examination.

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10.6. During submission of ONLINE application, a Registration Number will be issued to each applicant. For availing relaxation as admissible and free traveling facility (Second Class Railway Pass) for attending Trial/Document Verification. At the time of obtaining reservation and traveling, the Reservation Clerk and/or Ticket Checking Staff will ask for the original SC/ST certificate for verification of genuineness of the candidate.
- e) For Team Game, Candidates must upload the certificate of actually played the sport in the field issued by recognized sports Association/Federation/Board.

NOTE:- No print-out/hard copy of application complete in all respect and/or SC/ST certificate needs to be sent to the office.

12. INVALID APPLICATIONS/REJECTIONS: Candidates are requested to read all instructions thoroughly before submitting ONLINE application. Otherwise their applications are likely to be rejected on one or more of the following reasons. In case the application is rejected, candidates will be able to view their status ONLINE on the website of RRC along with the reasons for rejection(s). SMS and e-mail alerts shall also be sent to the candidates on their registered mobile numbers and e-mail IDs, if indicated in their ONLINE application. Candidates will not be intimated by post regarding the reason(s) of rejection.

14. Service Bond: The sportspersons recruited against Sport Quota shall execute the "Service Bond". The "Service Bond" period for the persons recruited against sports quota shall be of five years.

15. Legal matters: Any legal matter arising out of this employment notice shall fall within the legal jurisdiction of Allahabad only.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY BEFORE APPLYING:

The candidates should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post/examination.
