# 4. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

4.1. For GP 1900: The candidate should have minimum qualification of Intermediate or equivalent examination passed with 50 % aggregate. The condition of 50% marks is not to be insisted upon in case of SC/ST Candidate.

4.2. For GP 1800: Pass in Metric (10th) or ITI or its Equivalent or Higher education.

**Note:** Educational certificates/ qualification obtained from the institutions borne on the list of COBSE (Council of Board of School Education in India), an Association of National & State School Boards, will only be acceptable.

5. AGE: 18 - 25 years as on 01.01.2016. No age relaxation

6. RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The recruitment will be based or trials, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates who are found fit in trials will only be considered for next stage of recruitment process. The recruitment process will be finalized by the HQ office and respective divisions/workshops. An application/candidature of a candidate can be rejected at any stage, if found false and Railway will not communicate the reasons whatsoever.

#### 7. CONDITIONS FOR RECRUITMENT:

a) Before applying candidate should ensure that he/she fulfil the minimum eligibility norms as given in Para 3, 4, 5 & 6 above.

b) The name of the candidate and father's name appearing in school/college certificates and in sports certificates should be one and the same. There should be no difference.

c) The specific position (Full Back / Half/Forward/ Required Kgs/ Wicket keeper/All rounder etc.) played in the particular game/even

if applicable should be mentioned in the application without fail.
d) In team sports, only sportspersons who have actually played the sport in field shall only be eligible. Therefore, a sportsperson who represents as member of a team in any recognized sports event/championship but has actually not played in the field, shall not be considered for recruitment against sports quota.

e) For posts where there is initial training prescribed, candidates has to qualify the training before posting

f) A caste certificate on the prescribed format for recruitment in Central Government services issued by the competent authority in the case of SC/ST should be uploaded for the purpose of taking relaxation as admissible.

#### 8. Serving candidates:

Serving Railway staff and those working in Quasi-Administrative offices of the Railway organization such as Railway Canteens, Co-operative Societies and Institutes should have to upload No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by their employer.

## 9. EXAMINATION FEE:

9.3. For Unreserved/OBC Male candidates not coming within the purview of minority/economical backward classes/PWD/Ex Servicemen, examination fee is ₹ 100/- for all categories.

9.4. The examination fee is non-refundable. It should be paid ONLINE using internet banking or debit/credit cards (service charges apply for all which will be borne by the candidates). Applications not accompanied with examination fee, whereve required, will be summarily rejected.
