

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

All the admitted candidates for the post of APFC are again informed through this Notice of the Commission that:

- a) All the admitted candidates for the post of APFC are being allowed by the Commission to appear in the Recruitment Test. Scrutiny of applications of such candidates would be done after shortlisting through the Recruitment Test. Shortlisted Candidates would be asked to submit the documents in support of their claim for the post. Their documents will be scrutinized and those Candidates who fulfil all the eligibility conditions of the post shall be called for interview.
- b) The Candidates are directed to undertake the Recruitment Test at their own risk i.e. after verifying that they fulfil the qualifications as prescribed in the Advertisement, and their admission to the Test is purely 'provisional'.
- c) OBC Jat candidates may also note that:

“Notification published in the Gazette of India dated 04.03.2014 by which the Jat Community had been included in the Central List of Backward Classes for the States of Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, NCT of Delhi, Bharatpur and Dholpur districts of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

The aforesaid notification bearing No. 63 dated 4.3.2014 including the Jats in the Central List of Other Backward Classes for the States of Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, NCT of Delhi, Bharatpur and Dholpur Districts of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand was set aside and quashed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide Order dated 17.03.2015.”

Hence, OBC (Jat) and OBC (Creamy Layer) candidates are advised to check their eligibility with regard to age, educational qualification and other conditions for the post of APFC as on closing date i.e. 09.07.2015, before appearing in the Recruitment Test.”
