AGE LIMIT & RELAXATIONS:

i) The date for determining the upper age limit, qualifications and experience shall be the closing date prescribed for filing <u>online</u> application as indicated above **ie.** 6th **December**, **2016**.

ii) The age limit shown against all the posts is normal age limit as per Recruitment Rules. However, age is relaxable for SC/ST candidates upto 5 years and upto 3 years for OBC candidates in respect of vacancies reserved for them.

iii) Persons with Disabilities are eligible for age relaxation over and above the upper age limit prescribed by 5 years for posts at SI.No. 1 to 5 and by 10 years for 6 to 9 as per Govt. of India Rules.
