Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) is providing Statutory Services to the exporters under STP/EHTP schemes and also extending infrastructural facilities including High Speed Internet and IPLC links. STPI at present has 56 centres at different locations in the country.

Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for filling up of various Group 'C' vacancies as given below at STPI Thiruvananthapuram and its liaison office located at Kochi. The vacancies belonging to the S&T category are proposed to be filled up by direct recruitment on contract basis. The vacancy belonging to the non-S&T category is proposed to be filled up by transfer (absorption) of officers of the Central / State Govt. / PSUs / Autonomous Bodies / direct recruitment on contract basis. The recruitment on contract basis will be for a period of three years which is likely to be regularized / extended / terminated depending upon the performance of the candidate during the contract service.

How to Apply:

Candidates meeting the above eligibility requirements may fill up the application available online at the Web site www.tvpm.stpi.in. Applicants are required to take the printout of the filled-in application form and send the signed filled-in application form complete in all respects along with duly self-attested copies of certificates (as uploaded on the Web site) relating to qualification(s), date of birth, experience, caste, etc. by the last date of receipt of application to the Director, Software Technology Parks of India, C21, Thejaswini Building, Technopark, Thiruvananthpuram-695581, Kerala along with an application fee

of Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred only) per application by Demand Draft (having three months' validity) / Indian Postal Order in favour of "Software Technology Parks of India" payable at Thiruvananthapuram. No fee is required to be paid by candidates belonging to SC/ST/PH category. Female candidates are also exempted from payment of fee. Fee once paid shall not be refunded. Persons working in Central / State Government / PSUs / Autonomous organizations may send their applications through proper channel. It is also requested that advance action may be taken to keep the APARs for the last five years, of those candidates, ready along with their latest vigilance profile as regards (i) penalty imposed, if any during the last ten years, (ii) details of disciplinary action initiated/being initiated, if any, etc., to be furnished as and when the selection committee meeting is scheduled. However, a copy of the application may be sent in advance for consideration.

Those Candidates who have already applied against the Employment Notice No. STPITM/Rect/02/2015 may apply afresh subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria as given in this Employment Notice. In such case, they shall be exempted from payment of the fee for the post for which they have already paid.

Nature of Examination: Applications received on or before the last date shall be screened and all the screened-in candidates shall have to appear for a written examination. Candidates screened-in for the S&T post shall appear for a Trade Test in addition to the written examination. Both the written examination and Trade Test will be conducted in Bangalore.

The written examination for the non-S&T post will consist of Multiple Choice Objective Questions from Logical, Analytical Reasoning Capabilities, Quantitative, Qualitative abilities and Generic Awareness and Aptitude. The written examination for the S&T post will be a general one.

General Intelligence & Reasoning	It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding, statement conclusion, syllogistic reasoning etc. The topics are, Semantic Analogy, Symbolic/ Number Analogy, Figural Analogy, Semantic Classification, Symbolic/ Number Classification, Figural Classification, Semantic Series, Number Series, Figural Series, Problem Solving, Word Building, Coding & de-coding, Numerical Operations, symbolic Operations, Trends, Space Orientation, Space Visualization, Venn Diagrams, Drawing inferences, Punched hole/ pattern-folding & un-folding, Figural Pattern-folding and completion, Indexing, Address matching, Date & city matching, Classification of centre codes/ roll numbers, Small & Capital letters/ numbers coding, decoding and classification, Embedded Figures, Critical thinking, Emotional Intelligence, Social Intelligence, Other sub-topics, if any.

The upper age limit in respect of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and persons with disabilities shall be relaxable as per Govt. of India instructions. The upper age limit in respect of the candidates serving with Government, working on regular basis in STPI, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons shall be relaxable in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time. - 3. The candidates evaluated on the basis of CGPA or a similar method shall have to provide in writing exact Division from concerned University.
- 4. The eligibility of the candidates in terms of educational qualifications, experience, age, etc., will be determined based on the information furnished by the candidate on the closing date for receipt of applications. No adding of information shall be entertained after the closing date of receipt of applications.
- 5. Copies of Certificates duly attested in r/o proof of age, educational qualification(s), experience and certificate belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH category, etc. shall be sent along with application.
- 6. In case of Direct Recruitment, the appointment shall be on Contract basis initially for a period of three years including one-year probation which is likely to be regularized / extended / terminated depending upon performance of the individual during contract service.
- 7. STPI reserves the right to operate the post(s) of higher grade in the lower grade and to offer the appointment to the candidate in lower grade, in case the Selection Committee recommends.

- 8. Mere fulfillment of qualifications and experience requirements does not entitle candidates to be called for test.
- 9. Management reserves the right to fix the criteria for short-listing the candidates to be called for examination.
- 10.
